

ANNIVERSARIES

60 YEARS

1965 was a successful year for the Aussies. Roy Emerson and Margaret Court won their second Wimbledon singles crowns. John Newcombe and Tony Roche won the men's doubles title, while Court won the mixed doubles title alongside Ken Fletcher.



50 YEARS

1975 saw **Margaret Court** claim her fifth Wimbledon mixed doubles title.

40 YEARS

In 1985, **Liz Smylie** won the women's doubles title and **Paul McNamee** won the mixed doubles title.



30 YEARS

In 1995, **Todd Woodbridge**and **Mark Woodforde**won the men's
doubles title.

20 YEARS

Stephen Huss won the men's doubles title in 2005.

- The 138th edition of Wimbledon will be contested in 2025, with over 53 million pounds in prizemoney on offer
- Thirteen Australian players have received direct acceptance into the Wimbledon 2025 singles draws
- Sixteen Australians will compete in qualifying to earn a coveted place in the main draw
- Live Electronic Line Calling has been adopted for this year's Championships.
- The schedule for finals weekend has been changed with the men's doubles to start at 1:00 pm on the second Saturday, followed by the women's singles at 4:00 pm. On the second Sunday, the women's doubles will start at 1:00 pm, followed by the men's singles at 4:00 pm.
- The multi-year Millenium Building Project continues but the new look Players' Restaurant, extended terrace and new player warm-up area will be functional for this year's Championships.
- Former Wimbledon Champions, Billie Jean King, Bjorn Borg and Arthur Ashe will be celebrated this year.
